The following Inferences have been drawn by IQAC after perusing the online feedbacks collected through Google forms

Percentage of students who have rated teachers under the following categories

- a) Excellent = 1194
- b) Very good= 603
- c) Good= 301
- d) Satisfactory =379

# The recommendations by the IQAC

- 1. It is quite heartening to note that most of the teachers have been rated either excellent or very good.
- 2. The number of students who have rated teachers as Good or satisfactory are 680 which is 35% of the total feedbacks received

The following Inferences have been drawn by IQAC after perusing the online feedbacks collected through Google forms

Percentage of students who have rated teachers under the following categories

- a) Excellent = 802
- b Very good= 616
- c) Good= 701
- d) Satisfactory = 436

### The recommendations by the IQAC

- 1. It is quite heartening to note that most of the teachers have been rated either excellent or very good.
- 2. The number of students who have rated teachers as Good or satisfactory are 1137 which is 44% of the total feedbacks received.

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### Analysis of the Students' feedback of teachers for session 2018-19

The following Inferences have been drawn by IQAC after perusing the feedbacks collected from students about teachers

- 1. Overall satisfaction level of the students about various teaching –learning parameters = 80%.
- 2. Level of satisfaction of students with regards to "Teaching Skills" parameter = 72%
- 3. Level of satisfaction of students with regards to syllabi modification is = 45%

### The recommendations by the IQAC

- 1. It is quite heartening to note that most of the teachers are maintaining the standards of effective and efficient teaching. Further, that a perceptible positive change has taken place in the parameter which had registered a need for improvement in the previous year.

The following Inferences have been drawn by IQAC after perusing the feedbacks collected from students about teachers

- Overall satisfaction level of the students about various teaching –learning parameters = 80.5%
- 2. Level of satisfaction of students with regards to "Persuasion to consult books" parameter = 76%
- 3. Level of satisfaction of students with regards to syllabi modification is =57

- 3. The teachers need to motivate and cajole the students to consult books in library as this parameter has been highlighted by most of the students in their feedbacks.
- 3. 57% of the students are satisfied with the syllabi by this logic 43% want modifications. The teachers need to get more information from the students about the exact nature of the change they desire.

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### Analysis of the Students' feedback of teachers for session 2016-17

The following Inferences have been drawn by IQAC after perusing the feedbacks collected from students about teachers

- 1. Overall satisfaction level of the students about various teaching -learning parameters = 85%
- 2. The satisfaction level of students with regards to Extra -subject knowledge parameter of the teachers is least of all other parameters = 68%
- 3. Persuasion to consult books and accessibility is falling in the range = 80%
