Established as the first Women's college of Jammu Province by Maharani Tara Devi in 1944, during the rule of then Maharaja Hari Singh, the institution was formerly named appropriately as Maharani Mahila College. On 25th November, 1953 Maharani Mahila College was renamed as Govt. College for Women, Parade Ground, Jammu, and since then, it continues to be an institution of eminence. In keeping with the tradition of excellence, the college was granted Autonomy and CPC (College with Potential for Excellence) status by UGC in 2014 and 2016, respectively. In accordance with the mandate of NEP, GCW, Parade Ground, Jammu, is eager for a paradigm shift by introducing a number of skill based courses, vocational courses and research components from 2022-23 session. With more than 6000 students enrolled to pursue their undergraduate degrees in commerce, arts, science and humanities including PG in Home Science, Computer Applications, Zoology, English and Music. Academic flexibility as envisaged in NEP is reflected in the new course framework adopted by this college.


