PG ADMISSIONS (2023-24)

Guidelines for Admission to PG programme in English for the session 2023-24.

Total no of seats available = 50 + Supernumerary seats.

- Seats reserved for candidates who have studied English Literature/ English Honors as one of the subjects in the UG programme with aggregate of 50% marks = 30
- Seats reserved for candidates other than the ones with Literature/ English Honors at UG level with aggregate of 60% = 20

Note: the seats left unfilled due to non availability of candidates in any of the above referred categories (A &B) shall be filled from the available candidates as per the merit list irrespective of the category.

- Merit list shall be drawn on the basis of the performance of the candidates in the entrance test + the academic performance in the qualifying UG programme. The weightage for entrance test and academic performance shall be the same and has been already published in the notification for the PG admissions for the session 2023-24
- Reservation norms followed for various admissions shall also be applicable for both these categories
- Calculation of value points for the achievements under sports, NSS, NCC, etc categories shall be made by considering the PG Admission brochure of the University of Jammu session 2019 as the reference document.

Guidelines for Admission to PG programme in Music for the session 2023-24.

Total no of seats available = 20 + Supernumerary seats.

- Candidates with music as one of the subjects at UG level shall be eligible for admissions to the PG programme in Music with 50% aggregate.

- Candidates without Music as one of the subjects in the UG programme shall be eligible for admission in PG in music only after completion of bridge course in Music.
- The candidates who have pursued Skill course in music at the UG level even though not having music as a subject at the UG level shall also be eligible for admission. Such candidates shall not have to undergo any bridge course in music
- Reservation policy in vogue is applicable to these admissions also.
- Calculation of value points for the achievements under sports, NSS ,NCC, etc categories shall be made by considering the Admission brochure of the University of Jammu session 2019 as the reference document.

Guidelines for Admission to PG programme in Zoology for the session 2023-24.

Total no of seats available = 30 + Supernumerary seats.

- Candidates with zoology as one of the subjects at UG level shall be eligible for admissions to the PG programme in Zoology with 50% aggregate.

Guidelines for Admission to PG programme in Home-Science for the session 2023-24.

Total no of seats available = 18 + Supernumerary seats.

- Must have passed in the final year of Bachelor Degree Examination securing requisite percentage of 50% with BSc. Home-Science and BA with Home-Science as one of the subjects as the first preference.
- Second preference will be given to students having sociology or Psychology in BA with 50% aggregate.
- Third preference will be given to students who passed BA examination with 60% or more aggregate marks.

Guidelines for Admission to PG programme in MCA for the session 2023-24.

Total no of seats available = 30 + Supernumerary seats.

- Passed BCA/Bachelor degree in Computer science Engineering or equivalent degree Or passed B.Sc./B.Com/BA with mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduation level (with additional bridge courses as per the norms of the concerned university and obtained at least 50% marks in the qualifying examination.
